to live like me and you.

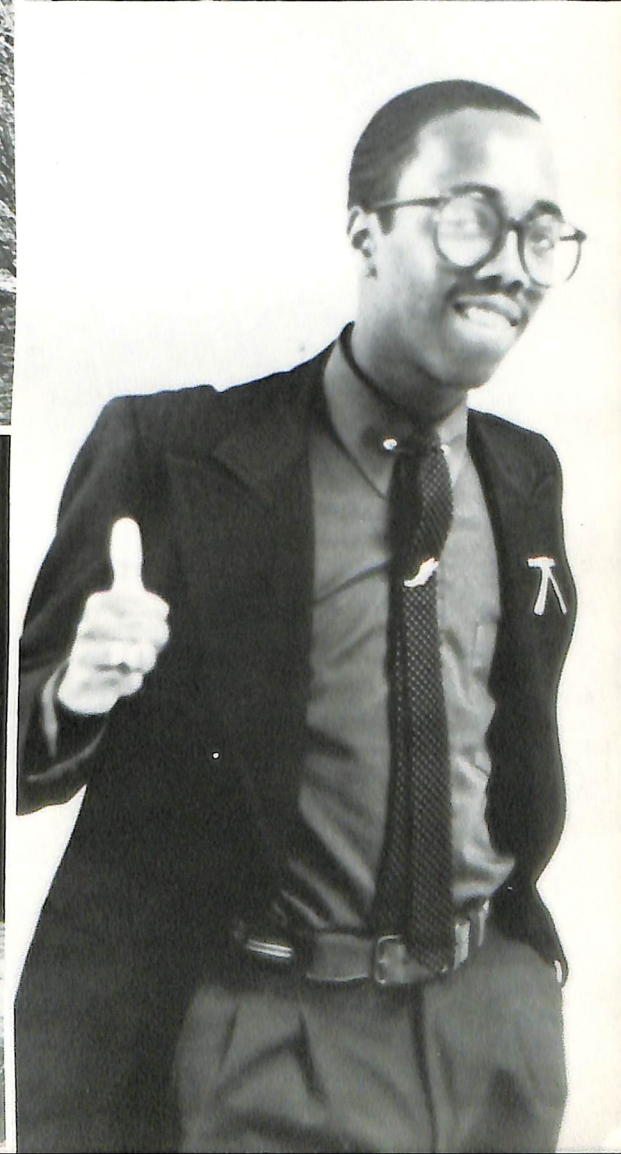
