A DSC Student Looks At Soviet Russia

Last summer, DSC was fortunate to have one of its students, Kenneth W. Livingston, make a personal tour of Russia. The following article reflects Mr. Livingston's personal opinion of what he saw.

SOVIET RUSSIA TODAY
By Kenneth Livingston

"Overshadowing the many varied experiences a trip to the Soviet Union affords is the realization that any number of personal friendships of great depth are possible with Soviet youth. They too share the almost universal interests of music, dancing, sports, and movies. Political differences present no barrier at getting to know each other. On the other hand, we found them to be well oriented politically. They were very keenly interested in the actions of their government, and, without hesitation, were able to discuss the regime's most recent move, their present standing, and their latest proposals.

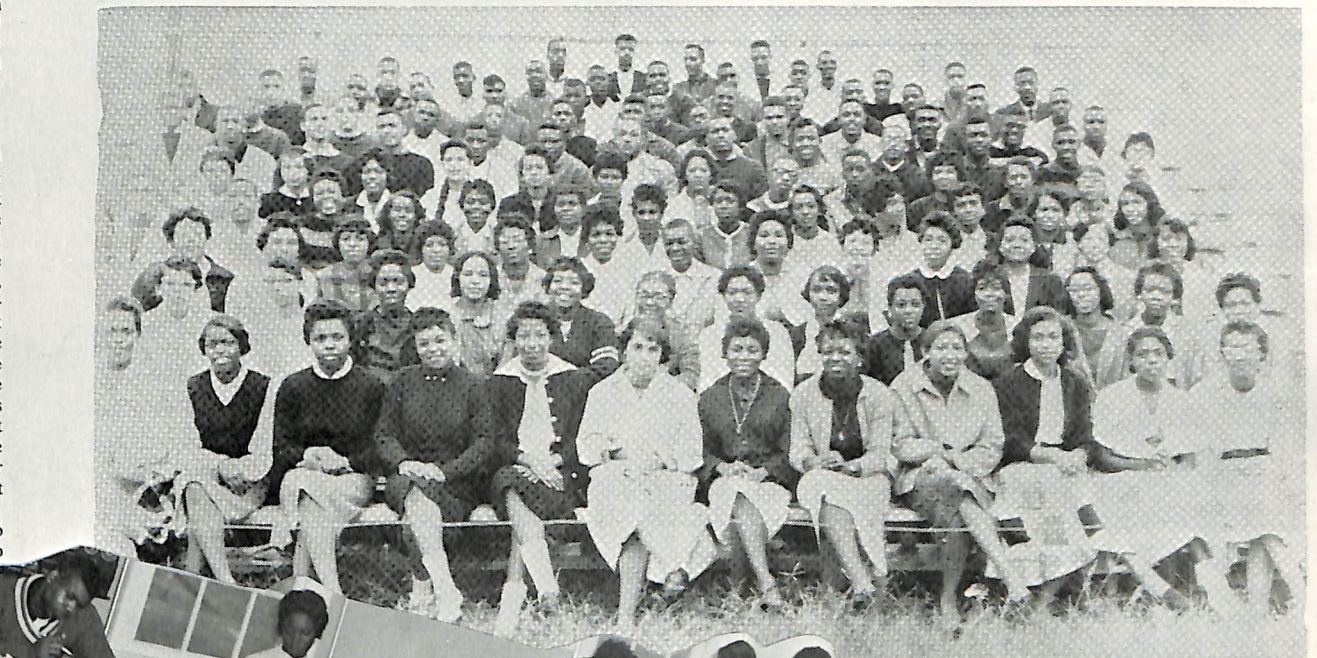
"This brought out attention to the great wave of provincialism so prevalent on the American campus, and the group could be more concerned with the problems for which we are responsible, but with the potential of the Soviet Union.

"People of all ages are curious about the life and ask a wide range of questions. The emphasis on living conditions, education, military, religion, and student life.

"The year 1960 is of significance to the Soviet Union. It is then that the current economic plan is expected to be realized: the Seven Year Plan. In its fruition, it will give the Soviet people a standard of living comparable to that of the United States. Colorful posters and sports demonstrations serve as tools reminding them of the results that their efforts will produce.

"Beginning this fall in the U. S. S. R., a new educational program, the Khrushchev School Reform, is being initiated. Generally speaking, the stress is towards higher education combined with a socially useful occupation. This means that following graduation from secondary school, service is required in some socially useful occupation. If an individual has done well academically, he is offered a stipended for study in one of the universities or technical schools. The most attractive offers are in the field of engineering. The first two years of the students, training are spent in an apprenticeship with classes at night. This adds labor to the forces of the Seven Year Plan.

"Contrary to public opinion, religion in the Soviet Union has not been entirely outlawed. Many churches are still open and are usually very crowded. Yet, many are now used for other purposes such as milk plants. Those that are open are attended largely by elderly people—mostly women. On a visit to the Protestant Church in Moscow, we were told that the seating capacity is one thousand, five hundred, but average attendance for a single service is close to three thousand. Noticing the absence of young people at the morning service, I later asked the minister, 'What percent of your congregation is made up of young people?' The answer, 'Twenty percent under thirty.' This twenty percent I did not see during the course of my visit. The presence of Communist guides in the room I think had a definite bearing on this.

the clock make. As long as it is out on matters of social concern, the church in the Soviet Union remains relatively undisturbed. The feeling of the Regime, seemingly, is that it will die out with the older generations.

"The value of this experience cannot be summed up in a few words, nor can it presently be realized in its entirety. Only as we relate it to the changing scenes of the present drama on the world's stage can its real significance come into focus."
